Affix	=	An additional element placed <u>at</u> the beginning or the end of a word, or in the body of a word, to modify its meaning (eg. a prefix or suffix).
Consonants	=	Ktunaxa Letters: ø, ø, h, k, k, L, ‡, m, m, n, n, n, p, p, q, q, s, t, t, w, x, y or ?.
Future Tense	=	A form of <u>verb</u> that relates it to a time in the Future.
Nouns	=	Words used to identify the Name of a Person, Place or Thing.
Plural	=	More than one of something.
Possession	=	To have something as property or to own something.
Prefix	=	An <u>addition to the beginning</u> of a word.
Present Tense	=	A form of verb that <u>relates it to</u> the Present Time.
Pronoun	=	A word that may be <u>used</u> <u>instead of a noun</u> (eg. I, You, She, He, It, This).

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Singular = One person or thing.
