

# Ktunaxa Grammar Rules- Glossary- List of Terms Used

The Following is a **Glossary of Terms and their Definitions** to reference while using the Ktunaxa Grammar Rules. (Referenced from Grammar Rules Booklet- Acknowledgements to the KKLK).

Term	Term Definition
<b>Affix</b>	= An additional element placed <u>at the beginning or the end of a word, or in the body of a word</u> , to modify its meaning (eg. a prefix or suffix).
<b>Consonants</b>	= <u>Ktunaxa Letters: ǰ, ǰ́, h, k, ḱ, L, ł, m, ḿ, n, ń, p, ṕ, q, q́, s, t, t́, w, x, y or ʔ.</u>
<b>Future Tense</b>	= A form of <b>verb</b> that relates it to a time in the Future.
<b>Nouns</b>	= Words used to identify the Name of a Person, Place or Thing.
<b>Plural</b>	= More than one of something.
<b>Possession</b>	= To have something as property or to own something.
<b>Prefix</b>	= An <u>addition to the beginning of a word.</u>
<b>Present Tense</b>	= A form of <b>verb</b> that <u>relates it to the Present Time.</u>
<b>Pronoun</b>	= A word that may be <u>used instead of a noun</u> (eg. I, You, She, He, It, This).

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<b>Singular</b>	=	One person or thing.
<b>Suffix</b>	=	An addition <u>to the end</u> of a word.
<b>Verb</b>	=	A word used to <u>describe an action</u> , state, or occurrence (such as hearing, seeing, running, etc.).
<b>Vowels</b>	=	<u>Ktunaxa Letters</u> : a, a·, i, i·, u, u·

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
